

IRUDIKA 2022 RESIDENCIES ILLUSTRATION CONTEST

The Irudika Residencies host an illustrator from international territory and an animator from national territory in the Fundación BilbaoArte Fundazioa, the Maison des Auteurs creation spaces within the Cité de la Bande Dessinée et de L'image d'Angoulême, as well as Impronta Casa Editora de Guadalajara and La Casa del Autor de Zapopan in Mexico to develop their own artistic project and generate the image of the Irudika International Festival in its 2023 edition. The results will be exhibited in the city of Vitoria-Gasteiz, concluding the artistic residency. The results will be exhibited in the Fundación Vital Fundazioa Exhibition Hall in the city of Vitoria-Gasteiz, concluding the artistic residency.

TWO CATEGORIES: ILLUSTRATION and ANIMATION 2023

Call for entries open from THURSDAY 25th AUGUST 2022 until SUNDAY 25th SEPTEMBER 2022 at 23:59 hours.

CALENDAR

The calendar for the residency will be from the 1st of March to the 13th of May and includes a presentation at Espacio ZAS Kultur in Vitoria-Gasteiz on 28th February. The residency will be held at the Maison des Auteurs in Angoulême, La Casa del Autor in Zapopan, Guadalajara, Mexico and at the Bilbaoarte Foundation. The residency ends with the opening of the exhibition and presentation of the poster in Vitoria-Gasteiz.

Production of pieces and final artwork for installation.

RESIDENCY FOR ILLUSTRATION PROFESSIONALS (FROM AROUND THE WORLD)

Irudika, with the support of **Fundación Vital Fundazioa** and in collaboration with **Fundación BilbaoArte Fundazioa**, the **Cité Internationale de la Bande Dessinée et de l'Image de Angoulême** (France), the **Guadalajara Government**, **Guadalajara Capital Mundial del Libro - Cultura Guadalajara** (Mexico) and **La Casa del Autor in Zapopan** (Mexico), launches this call aimed at professional illustrators.

OBJECTIVE.

The residency seeks to facilitate the creation of collaborative networks, promote the mobility of creators, foster creative production, and strengthen links between state and foreign cultural institutions.

The Residence aims to promote creation in the specific field of illustration. To this end, the resident from any chosen corner of the planet must develop a personal illustration project, the poster and graphic elements accompanying flyers for the next IRUDIKA 2023. These elements may be fragments of the poster itself. The design team will give guidelines before starting the residency.

RESIDENCY FOR ANIMATION PROFESSIONALS (FROM THE SPANISH STATE)

Irudika, with the support of **Acción Cultural Española (AC/E)**, and in collaboration with **Fundación Vital Fundazioa**, **Fundación BilbaoArte Fundazioa**, **la Cité Internationale de la Bande Dessinée et de l'Image d' Angoulême** (France), the **Guadalajara Government**, **Guadalajara Capital Mundial del Libro - Cultura Guadalajara** (Mexico) and **La Casa del Autor in Zapopan** (Mexico), launches this call aimed at animation professionals of Spanish nationality or accredited legal residence born or registered in Spain..

OBJECTIVE

The residency seeks to facilitate the creation of collaborative networks, promote the mobility of creators, foster creative production, and strengthen links between state and foreign cultural institutions. The purpose of the Residency is to encourage creation in the specific sphere of graphic animation. Therefore, the successful resident must produce a personal animation project, a short film of between 20 and 60 seconds, which will be used as a professional video at the next Irudika 2023 Festival

ELIGIBILITY CONDITIONS FOR RESIDENCES

Any individual, with legal capacity, over 18 years old, may apply. For the animation category, applicants must be able to prove Spanish nationality or legal residence in Spain. The successful applicant for the residency shall accredit that s/he either has the Spanish or European health card or private insurance that covers any medical contingencies that may arise during the residency period, always before starting the residential programme. Possible medical examinations, visa costs, etc. Required during the trips will be covered by the residents with their pocket money.

The resident shall undertake to provide the organisation with a list of technical requirements at least one month prior to the start of the residency. Any requirements that cannot be covered by the organisation shall be provided by the artist or s/he shall adapt her/his technique to the materials provided by the Maison des Auteurs de Angoulême or Bilbaoarte. The artist shall undertake to attend and responsibly make use of the spaces at all stages of the artistic residency. The organisers shall not be liable for the breakage or loss of the technology equipment being used and/or belongings of the residents.

As stated in the previous point, the chosen resident must develop a personal illustration project and the poster for the next IRUDIKA 2023, in the case of the illustration category, and a personal animation project and the bumper that will serve as the image for IRUDIKA 2023.

During the process, the resident will contribute weekly content on the creation of the work and its processes for the Irudika blog.

At the end of the project, an exhibition will be held where the illustrator will exhibit his/her work process and the Irudika 2023 poster/animation produced during the residency. The resident will take an active part in the assembly and dismantling of the exhibition.

The illustrator undertakes to deliver the poster in 600dpi psd format in layers to be able to use graphic elements on the web and flyers. The animator undertakes to provide the raw animation/movie and adaptation with promotional texts.

Likewise, the professional undertakes to make future reference to the fact that this project is the result of a residency organised by Irudika with the support Fundación Vital Fundazioa , Acción Cultural Española (AC/E), La Maison des Auteurs and the Cité Internationale de la bande dessinée et de l'image de Angoulême-France, Fundación Bilbaoarte, La Casa del Autor de Zapopan (Mexico) and Guadalajara City Council (Mexico), as well as the Basque Government, Diputación Foral de Araba, Spanish Ministry of Culture and Sport, Vitoria-Gasteiz City Council and Artium Museum.



AWARD

The selected resident shall receive:

1. Monetary award.

Irudika shall provide the resident with the gross sum of 2.450€, which will be paid in three phases:

- €150 gross (subject to a withholding of 15%)
- 1.300€ as travel expenses and per diems (without VAT or withholding). This amount is intended to cover travel expenses (local and between Euskadi and Angoulême), food and material, necessary for the development of the project. This amount will be paid at the beginning of the residency. Flights Bordeaux-Guadalajara and Guadalajara-Bilbao as well as accommodation are financed by the organisation.
- 1,000€ at the end of the project as remuneration for the transfer of the rights to the poster/animation resulting from the Irudika Illustration Residency 2023 (subject to a 19% withholding tax).

2. Accommodation, workspaces, and technical resources:

VITORIA-GASTEIZ. ZAS KULTUR SPACE

The city of Vitoria-Gasteiz, as well as hosting our event Irudika, opens and closes the residency phases thanks to local collaborators such as the Fundación Vital Fundazioa and the Espacio Zas Kultur. Arrival in Vitoria is scheduled for 28 February 2023 in the morning, in order to be able to attend to the press. The selected authors will take part in a discussion with Kike Infame. The talk will be organised within the framework of the Euskal Irudigileak gatherings at Espacio ZAS Kultur and will serve as a presentation of the projects to be developed during the residency, as well as an opportunity for the authors to make contact with the city. On the same day, they will be shown the room where the final exhibition will be held.

Also on that date, they will be given €1,300 to cover their travel expenses, food and materials, as well as €150 to cover one night's accommodation in Vitoria, the reservation of which can be arranged by the association of Basque illustrators and the Irudika team should the resident need it.

ANGOULÊME

Thanks to the twinning of the cities of Vitoria-Gasteiz and Angoulême, we have the support of this important institution with long recognition as promoters of culture in the field of comics. The accommodation will be located close to the workspace available at the Maison des Auteurs in Angoulême. You will be provided with a two-room flat, to be shared with another resident (details of the flat to be confirmed one month before the residency, but wifi connection outside the workspaces is not assured)

MÉXICO

The main novelty for this call is the inclusion of Guadalajara (Mexico) in the project on the occasion of its designation as "World Book Capital 2022" by Unesco, as one of the places where the selected projects will be developed. This collaboration also follows a long history of cooperation between Euskal Irudigileak, FIL Guadalajara and local cultural projects such as Impronta Casa Editora and Petra Ediciones. La Casa del Autor in Zapopan is also joining in by hosting the authors in its facilities, as a unique space in Latin America, twinned with La Maison des Auteurs de Angouleme, and whose aim is to promote the creation of works in the fields of graphic narrative, comics, digital animation and video game development. In turn, in Zapopan we collaborate with the MAZ Museo de Arte de Zapopan, creating a context in which the residents can receive stimuli for the creation of their projects, which they will bring back to Fundación Bilbaoarte to materialise and exhibit in a final exhibition in Vitoria Gasteiz, concluding the last stage. Accommodation and working space will be covered by La Casa del Autor de Zapopan. The Guadalajara Government, Guadalajara Capital Mundial del Libro - Cultura Guadalajara (Mexico) will cover subsistence within the initial amount as well as travel to and from France-Mexico-Spain.

They will also be able to use the facilities of Impronta Casa Editora to carry out reproduction tests of the graphic material created.

BILBAO

The Bilbaoarte Fundazioa Foundation is a space for artistic creation that has workshop masters in engraving, sculpture, etc. And where we are allowed to use the facilities in order to create the supports and final art to be exhibited in the final exhibition.

Stay in a two-room flat, to be shared with another resident, with internet connection covered by IRUDIKA, but it is not ensured internet connection outside the workspace.

Details of the flat to be confirmed one month before the residency. Workspace: Fundación BilbaoArte Fundazioa, where they will be able to work from Monday to Friday from 09:00 to 21:00. Here they will have the support of the medialab, new technologies, work and sculpture workshop technicians and will have the right to use a room/studio to work together with other professionals.

At Fundación BilbaoArte Fundazioa they will enjoy the advice regarding the installation of their work for the final exhibition. They will have access to the use of printing, plotter and silk-screen printing facilities, etc.

In the final exhibition, the illustrator will be able to exhibit the work produced during the residency, as well as material related to the creative process, sketches, etc.

HOW TO PARTICIPATE?

REQUIREMENTS CALL FOR ILLUSTRATION

Candidates wishing to be considered for the grant must submit:

- Completed application form.
- Curriculum vitae + 3 representative illustrations by the author
- Dossier (Between 2 and 5 pages). Description of the project to be undertaken during the residency, no more than 10,000 characters in length, and explaining the planned work, the theme, and techniques to be used. It may also be accompanied by drawings, sketches, or designs.
- A motivation letter.
- Affidavit that the candidate is the sole author of the submitted works.

REQUIREMENTS CALL FOR ANIMATION

Candidates wishing to be considered for the grant must submit:

- Census registration certificate
- Curriculum vitae, attaching some of their most representative works produced between 2018 and 2021, lasting a minimum of 30 seconds and maximum of 10 minutes in mp4 format and no more than 100 Mb in size.
- Description of the bumper project to be undertaken during the residency, no more than 10,000 characters in length, and explaining the planned work, the theme and techniques to be used. It may also be accompanied by drawings, sketches or designs.
- A motivation letter.
- Copy of the DNI, NIE, Passport or document accrediting the nationality or legal residence in Spain of the candidate.
- Affidavit that the candidate is the sole author of the submitted works.

SELECTION

A committee, convened by Irudika, shall review the applications and select the successful candidate, and then directly formalise the terms and conditions of the residency with the person chosen. The decision of the jury will be final.

The jury decision will be notified through the www.irudika.eus website and to the beneficiary at the email address provided. The Appraisal Committee may declare the Call void should it deem that none of the works submitted is of sufficient merit.

Date for submitting applications: from 25 of August to the 25 of September at 23:59 hours.

No application shall be accepted after that date.

JURY'S DECISION

The final decision of the winners of both calls will be published during the celebration of the sixth edition of Irudika at the Artium Museum in Vitoria Gasteiz, on Saturday 1 October 2022. The physical meeting of the juries will take place on Friday 30 September 2022.

CONDITIONS OF THE CALL FOR APPLICATIONS

1. Intellectual property. The participants shall be held liable for the originality and authorship of the projects that they enter and guarantee that they legitimately held all their intellectual property rights and, in that regard, they guarantee the peaceful use by the organisers and the latter will be expressly liable for any damages and/indirectly that failure to comply with this guarantee may incur.

The selected candidate shall expressly authorise the organisers to use her/his name in the way deemed appropriate within the purposes of this call.

2. Data protection. Participants accept that the personal data provided by virtue of this call for entries may be processed in the personal data files (participants in competitions, contracting and invoicing) owned by the organisers in order to be able to manage this call for entries.
